Son: Dad, would you like to save some money?

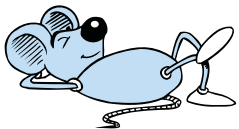
Dad: Certainly, what do you suggest?

you need and want. Imagine you want a car when you get older. If you start saving now, you'll save lots of money by the time you're ready to get a car. However, if you wait until you're almost old enough to drive to start saving for a car, then it might be too hard to save enough.



Learning to save money takes practice. You can save for anything -- a new video game, a trip to the movies, or even a college education.

Have your own savings account at the credit union -- it pays! Your money will be safe and we pay you dividends (money we give you for keeping your savings at the credit union).

Make a list of things you want to spend your money on. Put the list in order, starting with the things you want the most. This will help you figure out what you really want to save for.

If you're saving up for something special, like a new bike or toy, hang a picture of it on the wall or your bathroom mirror. This will remind you of your savings goal every day until you reach it.
